Canadian Panel Price Methodology: Many of the delivered Canadian OSB prices and all of the Spruce and Douglas Fir plywood prices on this page originated in the former Crow's newsletter. All delivered OSB prices in this section are derived from weekly market price assessments. The Spruce and Douglas Fir plywood prices are all derived from the Toronto 3/8-inch price. The 3/8-inch prices for other destinations are based on freight adders or deducts using Toronto as the base. In each destination column, the price for each thickness below the 3/8-inch price is derived from formulas using 3/8-inch as the basis. The 1-inch panel prices reflect additional costs at the manufacturing level.



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

Panel Market Report



Oriented Strand Board

Prices were mostly firm but flat heading into the U.S. Thanksgiving holiday. Logistical issues remained at the forefront of discussions in western markets. Availability of cars and trucks were problematic at mills in British Columbia due to recent flooding and mudslides. Shipments south into the I-5 corridor were especially troublesome.

Producers in Eastern Canada reported steady to strong business from customers north of the border. Reported prices gained in Eastern Canadian delivered markets. Prices firmed in the South. Deep discounts that surfaced last week in the Southwest dissipated. Mills stuck firmly to quotes at or near last week's reported levels and turned away counters. Sales were more active than usual for a holiday week as buyers covered December needs. Order files in the South ranged from early December to the year-end holidays. Carloads from the Southwest sold into Los Angeles and Phoenix at steep premiums. The Mountain States were quiet.

Southern Plywood

Tightened open-market supplies fueled steady price gains. Buyers with lean inventories and a just-in-time approach in recent weeks discovered dwindling availability in early trading and chased loads with mixed success in the days that followed.

Reported prices of rated sheathing climbed \$20-30 in most thicknesses. 19/32-inch was a strong seller in all zones. Sales of sanded AC/BC panels, underlayment, and concrete form were steady. Prices gained by double digits as well.



Mills spent some time off the market or quoted limited volumes intermittently. At least one producer extended order files to early January. Secondaries and treaters remained cautious, but replenished as dwindling inventories dictated.

Western Plywood

Strong sales extended order files, some into early January, and producers raised prices more aggressively and spent time off the market. Buyers typically favoring Southern Pine looked for coverage in Fir. Canadian buyers also purchased significant volumes of lower-priced, quickershipping CCX from western U.S. mills.

Double-digit increases in sheathing and underlayment were common, led by 1/2-inch 4-ply and 3/4-inch 5-ply increases of \$30. Price ranges widened in several thicknesses. Mills sold sanded and siding floor stock at discounts. An uptick in sales of underlayment boosted 23/32- and 1-1/8-inch prices.

Canadian Plywood

Order files pushed out into the latter half of January, prompting mills to limit offerings and go off the market. Although more thinly traded than the prior week, prices of Spruce and Douglas Fir panels increased by 4 points, propelling 3/8-inch, delivered Toronto, to \$593. Transportation issues, lean inventories, and limited availability created some panic among buyers, although winter's approach tended to calm those concerns. Canadian distributors turned to U.S. mills for lower-priced and quicker-shipping supplies.

Veneer

Trading was more active than many expected. Steady LVL business was accompanied by a boost in plywood orders. Traders in the U.S. took care of needs early in the week before turning their focus to the holiday, while Canadian traders were distracted by logistical woes in light of last week's storm. Prices were unchanged across the board.

Non-Structural Panels

Sales moderately faded ahead of the U.S. holiday, as many buyers and producers prepared for downtime. Demand for particleboard, MDF, and melamine kept pace with or exceeded supplies, and prices remained on firm footing.

Producers noted little benefit to extending order files more than a few weeks as raw material costs continued to rise, providing impetus for mills to keep upward pressure on quotes. "Resin prices aren't increasing, they're soaring," said a large producer in the East.


